## REOPENING

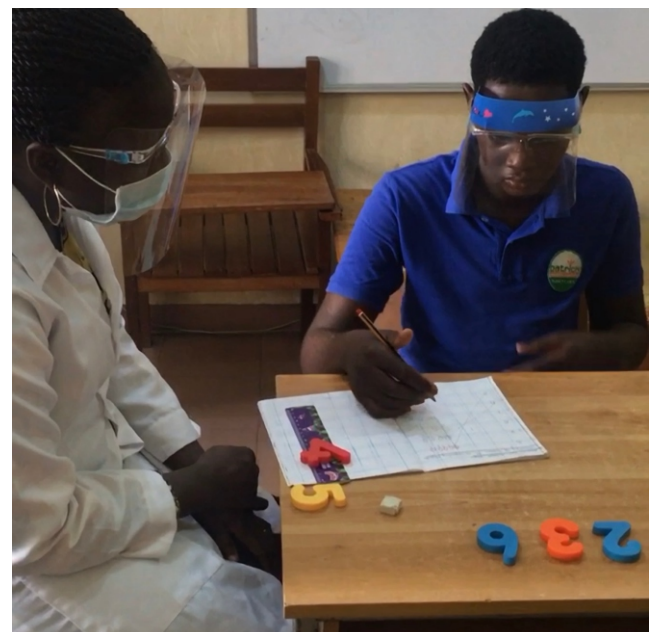

## COVID-19 TRAINING



Training was organized to help educate the staff about safety measures and precaution against the school reopening and as part of the safety measures, the Centre has implemented the following measures such as:

- Compulsory wearing of lab coat, face shield/mask for the staff
- Compulsory wearing of face shield for the children/adult



- Compulsory temperature check at the gate
- Compulsory washing of the hands regularly and placing of sanitizers at strategic locations around the school.
- Implementing intermittent cleaning of surface areas



- Placing of signs around the vicinity to educate visitors of our rules

### EYE TEST:



Precious sight foundation (eye specialist) visited the centre on the 23rd November 2020 to conduct free eye test for the staff and children at the centre. Reading glasses and eye drops were giving at no cost to

those in need of them. Parents were asked to indicate interest if they want their child(ren) to participate in the exercise.

### SENSITIZATION OF THE ADULT:

Titan TV shows visited the Centre to educate the young adults about safe Covid practice, and also to affirmation that they had to keep pushing through amidst their disabilities. Titan TV show airs on Sunday 4pm to 5pm on African magic family and on TVC 8pm to 9pm on Sunday.

## **SCHOLARSHIP**

We desire to put in our best resources to help our children always, therefore we would like to use this opportunity to solicit for support from our parents/organizations for our desire to continue to support families struggling financially. ## **LATE PICKING/DROP OFF**

The school management commends our parents who consistently make an effort to get their children to school early. However, we would like to remind our parents that therapy starts 9.00am and children should resume before 10.00am. A warning letter will be served if a parent comes late for three consecutive times in a term, after which the child will be sent back the fourth time. Consequently, we would like to emphasize that our school closes at 2p.m daily. A warning letter will be served for late pick up for 3 consecutive times, after which a surcharge of N5,000.00 will follow. We want our children to benefit from therapy, and like we know the time spent in therapy

MUST not be shorten.

Also, be reminded that no child is allowed into school before 7.30a.m, because there will be no staff to receive him/her, as the school needs to be cleaned and set for the day.

**N/B:** Our virtual session will be between 8am-9am and 1pm-3pm in the afternoon from next term.

Biscuits and juice will no longer be accepted at our centre. If this is put in the child's bag as snacks, we will NOT give to the child; instead we will trash the biscuits. Only healthy snacks and fruits will be allowed.
