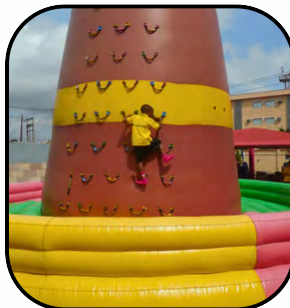




CHILDREN'S DAY
