One of the highlights of the term was the Centre's annual Children's Day Outing to Providah Fun City, Ikeja, Lagos, which provided the children and young adults with an exciting opportunity to enjoy recreational activities in a safe and stimulating environment outside the Centre.

The outing formed part of the Centre's social skills development programme, aimed at promoting social interaction, community participation, confidence building, and leisure skills. Accompanied by staff, the participants enjoyed a wide range of age-appropriate games and attractions, including arcade games, virtual reality experiences, rides, and interactive activities that encouraged teamwork, communication, coordination, and motor skill development.



A particularly memorable highlight was the group dance session, where children and staff came together to enjoy music and celebrate the day in a joyful and inclusive atmosphere. The outing also provided valuable opportunities for students to interact with their peers and teachers in a relaxed setting, strengthening relationships and fostering positive social experiences.

The children thoroughly enjoyed the experience, with many expressing excitement and a desire to return. The outing was a resounding success, creating lasting memories while supporting the Centre's goal of promoting holistic development through meaningful community-based experiences.

Gazelle Studio

Gazelle Studio resumed activities successfully during the reporting period, with young adults actively engaged in vocational, production and skills-development activities.

Product enquiries increased during the quarter, particularly for weighted vests. However, conversion of enquiries into confirmed orders remains below expectations, highlighting the need for strengthened marketing and distribution efforts.



The young adults continue to demonstrate encouraging progress in practical vocational and production skills, confidence building and employability development.

Patrick Training Academy

The 20th Cohort of the Autism and Special Needs Training Academy was successfully completed during the term, with 34 participants from diverse professional backgrounds, including educators, therapists, caregivers, and healthcare practitioners.

A notable milestone was the introduction of the Academy's first Student Handbook, providing participants with clear programme guidance and learning resources.

Participants received comprehensive training in autism, special needs education, behaviour management, communication, inclusion, and intervention strategies. Following the successful completion of final examinations on 6 June 2026, the cohort graduated on 4 July 2026 in a well-attended and successful ceremony, demonstrating significant growth in knowledge, practical skills, and professional confidence.

The Academy also expanded its online learning platform, with Cohort 3 Online commencing on 11 July 2026. Classes have been progressing smoothly, attracting participants from various locations and further advancing the Academy's commitment to building professional capacity in autism and special needs support.

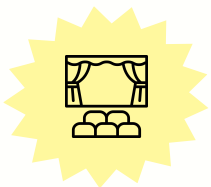

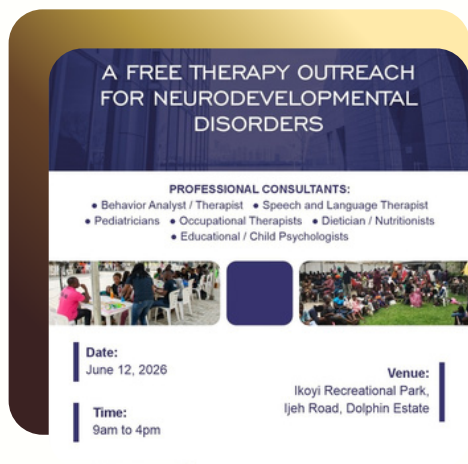
Grant

The Centre continues to make significant progress in the implementation of the Community Ability Intensive Project (CAIP), funded through a ₦10 million grant from the Roseline Emenike Foundation (REF). The project is designed to improve access to early identification, intervention, support services, and capacity building for children with developmental disabilities and their families within the community.

During the reporting period, the first phase of the project was successfully completed following the receipt of the first tranche of ₦5 million. This phase focused on community outreach and awareness activities and directly benefited 34 families through developmental screenings, consultations, caregiver support, referrals, and public awareness initiatives. The outreach programme increased community awareness of developmental disabilities and provided families with access to much-needed information and professional guidance.

Building on the success of the outreach phase, preparations are currently underway for the second phase of the project, which will focus on the training and empowerment of children and caregivers. Scheduled to run from August 2026 to April 2027, this phase will provide structured training sessions, practical skill-building opportunities, caregiver education, and ongoing support aimed at enhancing the capacity of families to meet the developmental needs of their children. The programme is expected to strengthen caregiver competence, promote positive developmental outcomes, and improve the overall quality of life for participating children and their families.

The Centre remains grateful to the Roseline Emenike Foundation for its support and partnership in advancing community-based disability inclusion and family empowerment initiatives.
